

BOMB THREATS

The Peru Central School District Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to work collaboratively with the Administrative Team to develop and maintain a district-wide response plan to bomb threats.

Administrators, teachers and support staff are to treat the protocols associated with the district-wide response plan as confidential information, not to be released to the public.

At the start of each school year, and upon updating of the district-wide response plan, each school's Principal is to share, as appropriate, the protocols to be followed by that school's instructional staff, support staff and substitutes.

At the start of each school year, and upon updating of the district-wide response plan, the district's business administrator is to share, as appropriate, the protocols to be followed by district office personnel, support staff supervisors and support staff members associated with cafeteria operations, buildings & grounds, transportation and all other district-wide operations.
